WHAT IS MANDALA?

Mandala represents a circle in Sanskrit language. Mandala is a joint of 2 words "Manda" meaning essence and the "LA" means container, which translates to container of essence. Mandala signifies that every wave has a centre, around which the action takes place. We can compare the centre to life around which all things revolve. True to its name, Mandala art is all about representation of the cosmos, the Universal energies, the self and the balance within the circle. There is only evolution!

Sacred Geometry is referred to as the "Art of the Universe" and is found all through the natural world. It is also one of the very few forms that appeal to and balance the left and the right brains. It is the art and science which connects us to the cosmos. Sacred Geometry reveals the source creation of the universe, and the evidence can be seen in the natural world around us.

Observing Mandalas and in conjunction with Sacred Geometry can give us a deeper understanding and spiritual meaning of the nature and Universe, which in turn aligns the soul and spirit with the universe and helps in developing a greater sense of awareness in yourself as well as in your spiritual practice.

HOW TO OBSERVE THE MANDALAS

Zero - We begin with a history of the same points that are at the center of the Mandala. From there, geometry tells us the story of how shapes take their form. The zero-dimensional point enters the first-dimensional community through the addition of


another point to create a line. By adding a third point to the mix, you get 2 dimensions. Things get deep, so to speak, when 4 points come together, creating 3 dimensions. After a tour of the shapes, you would enter the realms of patterns, which will enhance your appreciation of the shapes you just visited.

POINTS IN COMMON

Structured things usually need a centre or a point to organise around. For example, material substances are made up of particles that seem to move around a central nucleus. In conversations, having a main point is crucial; without it, our lives may feel purposeless.

But can we identify the exact point or centre of everything? In physics, when we closely look at tiny particles using powerful magnification, we discover that space is filled with the potential for things to exist.

The basic shapes we infused in our art as follows.



SIGNATURE MANDALA

A Signature Mandala is a unique creation formed using the Akshara Sankhya and Katapayadi numbering system. The process involves converting a name or statement into numbers, compressing them digitally, placing them within a segmented circle, and connecting them to form a visually appealing shape. This personalised approach infuses the Mandala with natural power, making each one distinctive and tailored to the individual or project.





From nothingness (the central depiction), we evolve until we reach the so-called pinnacle from where we descend and arise again in loops (the exterior depiction -Torus). The evolution becomes stronger when the descent happens into emptiness each time.

Elements and Senses Conjunction

DESCRIPTION: Elements and Senses Conjunction. The 5 elements in nature (centre) provide the foundation of the Universal Energy connect to the beings. When we live with awareness, these work in conjunction with our 5 senses (inner pentagon) in perfect balance providing the protection to our self (outer pentagon) providing a meaningful wholesome calm life (concentric circles in blue).



DESCRIPTION: Every being is spiritual by nature. The blueprint and cycle of life (Flower of Life at centre) is guided by the two components of personality - wisdom and emotion (the 2 crescents), sharpened and protected by the instruments of the Universe (Spears). This is done with harmony and balance (triangle), ultimately directed at the source of all energies (Srichakra) in nothingness (dark background).

DEPICTION: Spiritual path. Also depicting the Shiva family (Flower of Life) – Shiva, Tusks (Crescents) – Ganesha, Spear (Vel) – Karthikeya and Srichakra - Shakti.

DESCRIPTION: At the centre, in blue is the 'Flower of life' appearing in a hexagon shape. The flower of life represents the blueprint of the universe - the DNA. This comprises 19 overlapping circles with 90 petals, 54 triangles and represents that all existence, creation, as well as knowledge originated from the same source. You can see this visually, beginning with the centre circle and moving outward with each loop. It represents harmony, connection with Nature and the Universe, a visual depiction of life, and growth.

This lies within a hexagon, the most common shape found in the universe. It is also the most stable and the strongest binding shape in existence.

This is surrounded by the Torus which is a graphical representation of the balance between spirit and matter - this only happens when energy is aligned.

The basic form of the Torus explains the ascent from matter to the spirit or the descent from spirit to matter through a tube of consciousness, energy, or light. It is believed that an object's energy can only go so far in a single direction before doubling back and returning to its source.

This also represents the ascent or growth of self which is limited within a particular cycle after which it goes into descent and the cycle repeats itself, growing bigger each time as the individual evolves with harmony of energies and balance.

UNIQUENESS of The Creation - The Creative!

This creative represents the harmony of creation, life and the constant balance in the Universe. All creations emanate from the same source and have the trademark DNA (Flower of Life). This happens – in a calm grounded manner (blue colour) within a powerful framework of stable purpose (hexagon).

All creations then evolve, gain energy and maintain the Universal balance, the positivity (Sphatika) - as it ebbs, flows through crests and troughs in multiple cycles (Torus) represented in pink upward triangles and brown downward triangles while growing in stature all the time (green background).

There is the appearance of a quartz stone, Sphatika - which is a powerhouse of energy and positivity that absorbs, stores and amplifies positive energy. It also wards off negative energy!

The eye in the middle of the intersecting circles bearing three parts represents

'inner vision' = 'unity' (physical), 'spiritual sight' = 'service' (spiritual) and 'higher knowledge' = 'recovery"(mind).

These exist within the circle where the circle represents 'harmony' and 'wholeness'. A circle indicates circular form of energy which is never ending.



So Many Petals!

DESCRIPTION: 'Sahasrara' means 1000 petals of a lotus which relates to complete consciousness. It signifies a person's crown chakra and the totality of one- self. The consciousness here is related to 'Divinity' and 'Enlightenment'. The several points joining each petal here, relates to God and Unity.

Significance of the Lotus: 'Just as the lotus can never be affected by soils dirt, so also the soul cannot be troubled by dirt of the body' - as demonstrated by Gautama Buddha.

The lotus also has all powers to break the physical barriers which bind its rise. Thus, portraying that pure consciousness of a human will give him the potency to upsurge.

A lotus has 1000 differntly coloured petals. A yogi reaches zenith of his consciousness when Kundalini energy travels to the Sahasrara chakra through the lower chakras. At this point, the yogi's consciousness unites with consciousness of the cosmos. At this stage, the yogi can leave the body (physical state) and unite with supreme consciousness.

Panchakshari Awakening

DESCRIPTION: The Panchakshari Mantra – Na-ma-Shi-va-ya (the symmetrical pattern in the centre), acts as therapy for our soul, which in turn energises our self. The re-energized soul awakens into awareness and realisations (spokes from the centre) in the purity of the vast Universe (white background), forming the core of self-expansion.
